## **Deutscher Akademischer Austauschdienst (DAAD) -German Academic Exchange Service**

The DAAD grants scholarships to outstanding students (age limit 32 years). Applicants are expected to have already undertaken steps towards securing acceptance from a German host institution at the time of application. At present scholarships for M.Sc.-programmes are mainly bound to the **region Central America**.

Those interested in DAAD scholarships should contact either the German diplomatic representation or the local DAAD office in their home country. There, information can be obtained with regard to documents required, deadlines, date of pre-selection (as a rule about one year before taking up the studies) and institutions where applications have to be directed to (**applications cannot be addressed directly to DAAD head office**). Candidates should also inquire whether or not direct exchange relations exist with Germany. Additional Scholarships may be available where regional partnerships between particular countries and Germany may exist. In some countries scholarships are provided directly from Germany to individual institutions of higher education. The nomination of scholarship holders lies then in the responsibility of the respective foreign institution of higher education.
