

KEVIN PARRIS: Short Biography

Economist, OECD, Paris, since 1984, working on policy analysis, with particular focus on agri-environmental issues, especially policy issues related to sustainable management of water in agriculture (quantity, quality and climate change) and monitoring environmental performance.

Graduated from University of Reading, United Kingdom (1974), and obtained a PhD in agricultural economics from Reading (1980). Previously held academic posts at the Universities of Wales (1977), Oxford (1982) and Reading (1980-81).

Previous research positions were held at the UK Foreign Affairs Ministry, London (1978-79); UNCTAD, Geneva (1982); FAO, Rome (1982-83); and was on secondment from OECD with the Australian Bureau of Agricultural and Resource Economics (ABARE), Canberra, for one year in 1992/93.
