

Prof. Dr. Alfonso Sousa-Poza

Alfonso Sousa-Poza holds a Full Professorship in Economics at the University of Hohenheim in Stuttgart (Germany), and is a Director at the Institute for Health Care & Public Management. He is also a permanent guest lecturer in economics at the University of St. Gallen (Switzerland), and a Research Fellow of the Institute for the Study of Labour (IZA), Bonn. Alfonso Sousa-Poza is the coordinating and founding co-editor of the Journal of the Economics of Ageing (Elsevier).

Alfonso Sousa-Poza studied computer science at the University of Cape Town, and economics at the University of St. Gallen in Switzerland, from which he obtained his PhD in 1999.

His primarily empirical research interests are in the fields of ageing, health, labour and population economics. He has published among others in the Journal of Health Economics, Journal of Population Ageing, Journal of Population Economics, Health Economics, and Labour Economics.

He has worked regularly as an expert or consultant for institutions such as the World Bank, European Commission, OECD, Swiss Federal Statistical Office, Swiss National Science Foundation, Bertelsmann Foundation, Swiss Federal Department of Economic Affairs, UBS, Swisscom, Randstad, Avenir Suisse Foundation, Swiss Employers Association, as well as several law firms and courts.
