

# Checklist Initiation of the Doctoral Procedure Faculty of Business, Economic and Social Sciences - Doctoral Regulations 2019 -

## **Documents**

- 1. Application
- □ Application, generated from Docata
- □ Completed application, signed by doctoral candidate and supervisor
- □ Reviewers: 1<sup>st</sup> reviewer (supervisor), 2<sup>nd</sup> reviewer (from the same or another institute than the supervisor or from outside of Hohenheim)
- □ Examination committee: 1<sup>st</sup> reviewer (supervisor), 2<sup>nd</sup> reviewer, 3<sup>rd</sup> examiner (= a professor of the Faculty of Business, Economics and Social Sciences who acts as the chair of the examination committee).

Beware: Only two of the three examiners can be members of the same institute, but not of the same department. If a cumulative thesis is involved, at least one of the reviewers must not be a co-author of the articles included in the dissertation.

### 2. Further Documents

- □ Curriculum vitae (signed and dated)
- □ Summaries of the doctoral thesis in English and German (approx. 2 pages each), signed by supervisor and doctoral candidate
- □ Signed affidavit (Annex 3 of the Doctoral Regulations 2019)
- □ Signed instruction to the affidavit (Annex 4 of the Doctoral Regulations 2019)
- □ Signed declaration confirming content of digital version of thesis (Annex 5 of the Doctoral Regulations 2019)
- Declaration on the use of generative AI systems in dissertations and habilitation theses
- □ ID card/passport for checking correct name/s, date and place of birth

### When submitting a cumulative dissertation, please provide additional documents:

Requirements:

Typicall, a cumulative dissertation will include 3 articles in peer-reviewed journals/conference contributions.

Applicants must be a single author in at least one article (published or unpublished) or a lead author in at least one published article.

#### 3. Dissertation

- □ 1 printed, firmly bound copy of the thesis (glued binding)
- □ Title page in accordance with Annex 2 of the Doctoral Regulations 2019 (without university seal)
- □ Summary (in German and English), approx. 2 pages each
- □ Curriculum vitae (signed and dated)
- □ Signed affidavit (Annex 3 of the Doctoral Regulations 2019)
- Declaration on the use of generative AI systems in dissertations and habilitation theses
- □ Electronic version of the doctoral thesis (as a pdf file on a CD-ROM)

## A cumulative dissertation must include the following additional documents:

#### Requirements:

Typically, a cumulative dissertation will include 3 articles in peer-reviewed journals/conference contributions.

Applicant must be a single author in at least one article (published or unpublished) or a lead author in at least one published article.

- □ Title page for each chapter/each article with the following key information: title, abstract, keywords, (co-)authors, status
- Declaration of co-authorships for each article (as scans)

All documents must be submitted with original signatures. Only coauthors outside of Hohenheim are allowed to sign with scanned signatures.

- > Pdf-file 1: All application documents (items 1 and 2 of checklist)
- > Pdf-file 2: Dissertation (item 3 of checklist)

The <u>Graduate Academy checks</u> your pdf-material and may ask for amendments. <u>PRINTING</u>: Only once you have <u>received confirmation</u> that your files are in order.
