



## Scholarship Announcement for International Students

The Office of International Affairs awards a limited number of scholarships for international students with an international higher education entrance qualification (Bildungsausländer) within the framework of the DAAD scholarship and guidance-counselling programme STIBET. These are as follows:

- **Graduation scholarships (Studienabschluss-Stipendien)**
- **Short-term scholarships (Kurzzeit-Stipendien mit Betreuungsleistung)**

These scholarships aim to support foreign students who are, through no fault of their own, facing financial difficulties to enable them to concentrate on their studies and successfully finish their degree programme. Applicants for a short-term scholarship are expected to provide support to other foreign students in co-operation with the Office of International Affairs.

**Applications are open to foreign students who are enrolled in a regular Bachelor's or Master's degree program at Hohenheim and are already working on their Bachelor or Master thesis.**

Criteria for the selection of applicants are as follows:

- **strong academic performance**
- **financial need/hardship**
- **social commitment and/or student involvement in university life are welcome**

The following application documents are required:

- a **statement of motivation** including details regarding previous scholarships and explaining the current financial situation (part time jobs, etc.)
- a detailed **curriculum vitae** illustrating your previous studies
- **current transcript of records (Notenspiegel)**
- a letter of recommendation from the respective thesis advisor regarding current status and expected progress.

**The scholarships will be awarded by a selection committee on the basis of the quality of the applications whereby particular consideration is given to the current study achievements. Students who have self-financed their studies up to now by working are especially qualified for the scholarships. Incomplete applications cannot be taken into consideration! Not qualified to submit an application are non-degree students, doctoral candidates as well as students receiving another scholarship from the public purse during the same period.**
