



The Faculty of Natural Sciences at the University of Hohenheim is offering

**one scholarship for outstanding participants
in the Doctoral Study Program “Hohenheim Graduate School of Life Sciences” (HGL)**

The scholarship will be awarded for a period of two years, starting in May 2026, according to the framework of the Landesgraduiertenförderungsgesetz/The State Graduate Support Act (LGFG). An extension of a maximum of 12 months can only be granted in exceptional and well-founded cases, and provided that funding is available. Applicants must be formally admitted doctoral candidates at the Faculty of Natural Sciences at the University of Hohenheim. Please note that scholarship holders must apply for and participate in the Doctoral Study Program “Hohenheim Graduate School of Life Sciences” (HGL) (<https://www.uni-hohenheim.de/en/hohenheim-graduate-school-of-life-sciences>). If not already admitted, an application for admission must be submitted alongside the scholarship application; if admitted, the letter of admission must be submitted as part of the application.
